Jürgen is the Great Grandson of Gustav Johann Ferdinand Wietzke (m Ernestine Henriette Mathilde Müller), the only one of six living children who remained in Europe. He was the brother of Bertha Weitzke Knuth (mother of Frank Knuth Sr. who m Mary O. Marzka). Other children who immigrated to the U. S. include Frank Sr. (m Johanna Czirwinsky), Augusta (m Henry Mielke), Albertina (m William A. Rudnick), and Herman (a bachelor). Bertha and husband Frederick Knuth, Frank Sr., and Augusta all lived near each other in Pittsburgh. The Rudnicks moved to Nebraska and Herman bought a farm near Miller Station in 1908.

2. Turn left at US-6N E go 2.5 miles
3. Turn right at Erie St go 0.1 mile
4. Turn left at PA-99 S/Meadville St Continue to follow PA-99 S for 6.6 miles
5. Turn left at McClellan St go 0.2 mile
6. Take the 1st left onto US-19 N/US-6 E/N Main St go 0.3 mile
7. Slight right at Miller Station Rd/State Route 1016
